Guest Presentation: Sheriff Wilkerson and representatives from LCSO had a presentation to discuss evacuation notices and the process for how and why evacuations happen. A document will be sent out after the meeting from LCSO to share some additional information. The intent of the presentation is to provide further and more detailed awareness of the various forms of emergency evacuation notices and the larger impacts to be considered by the resources requesting those in the initial stages of an incident.

Agency Reports

LCSO: Sheriff Office's around the state feeling the strain with wildland fires on going.

Region 5: CTE Program: 72 participants throughout the year (representing 10 of the 16 school districts)

21 received their FF1, FEMA Portfolio, EMR, and Hazmat Certification

26 received their EMR

12 received their Red Card Cert

Several students have joined Dayton, McKenzie, and Junction City Fire Departments, as well as joined summer crews to fight wildfires

The program received a donated fire engine from Row River (with many supplies/hoses, etc) for use next year

Many donations came in for turnouts and supplies from all over the state
Gratitude to Lane Fire Authority, Coburg Fire, Eug-Spfld Fire, and Oregon Department of Forestry for hosting various skill days throughout the year

We are excited as we look ahead to next year-- hoping to connect more students to their local fire departments and support year 2 students in completing certifications.
