



# Intermediate ICS For Expanding Incidents ICS 300

**Course Description:** ICS-300 is a command level course that provides training and resources for personnel who require advanced knowledge and application of the ICS to complex incidents. This course expands upon information covered in the ICS-100 and ICS-200 courses. *Course participants will receive a FEMA Certificate upon successful completion.* **FEMA Student ID Number is required to take this course.** <https://cdp.dhs.gov/FEMASID>

## Prerequisites:

*Required* - IS 100, 200, 700, & 800  
*Recommended*- 2+ years of field experience

## Target Audience:

City/County employees, First Responders, Law Enforcement, Fire Fighters, Public Works, Public Health, Emergency Management, IMT Team personnel, and any individuals assigned to work in the Emergency Operations Center (EOC).

## Course Objectives:

- Describe how the NIMS Command and Management component supports the management of expanding incidents.
- Describe the incident/event management process for supervisors and expanding incidents as prescribed by the Incident Command System (ICS).
- Implement the incident management process on a simulated expanding incident.
- Develop an Incident Action Plan for a simulated incident.

### Obtain a FEMA Student Identification Number

- **Federal Student Identification (SID) is required for each student.** DHS/FEMA has directed the implementation of the Federal SID for all HSNTP granted funded participants. If you have attended a federal training in the past 18-24 months you may already have SID #; if so select the option "Forgot Your FEMA SID?".
- **The procedure for obtaining a SID number:**
  1. To register, go to <https://cdp.dhs.gov/femasid>
  2. Click on the "Register for a FEMA SID" button near the top the screen.
  3. Follow the instructions and provide the necessary information to create your account.
  4. You will receive an email with your SID number. You should save this number in a secure location.
