Agency Reports

CLCC: Quick discussion about fire season changes in the dispatch protocols for fire season and not fire season response parameters such as smoke investigations and burn complaints. Swisshome Deadwood joins CLCC July 15th. MCS protocol changes for how dispatch happens in the field.

OSFM: Estimate pre-po for this season may become more likely. Fire prevention co-op discussion about structuring and future deployment of this team.

LCSO: No report.

Emergency Management: OEM was able to receive funding for maintaining the Genesis program.

ODF: Moderate fire danger effective 6/19. Crews in Western Lane fully staffed. Training for the next couple weeks and a little fluctuation. 82W contract still working but hopefully mid-July. Creswell timeline for the type 1 should be similar. Working through getting support in place. Currently 2-hour call back on a day-to-day basis.

Region 5: Low attendance, the ask is to encourage your training officers to participate in the meetings and to help provide feedback etc. Looking for officer elections and need for president and secretary/treasurer. Follow the website for more.

CTE Program: No Report.

LCC Advisory: No Report

Radio Report: RIT system is onboard with the network and improvements are made for VHF RIT. Not pursuing the AFG grant because a lack of host. Current negotiations with LRIG for joining the UHF side with a decent proposal. Updates to go to the governance group.

Wildland: Wallace is gone 25th of the month for vacation. Task force 1, the Lane County in area task force is in service and the reminder is to check and stay informed with what your resource desire it.

Old Business: No Reports

New Business: Row River asking for assistance with OSFM grant support for summer staffing and use of volunteer stipends in lieu of career staffing/hiring of employees.

ESF gave a brief update on the whole blood program coming to Lane County via ESF. Whole blood will be carried with EMS 1 for ESF.

Caven is taking on representation for a couple Counties for representation within OFCA. Willing to channel needs and feedback to the association.

South Lane gave a brief update on alarm response changes happening July 1st. Dropping to one staffed ambulance daily with an engine staffed with the ambulance being dedicated to in district calls as the priority.

ESF gave an update related to hospital wall time and delays and a legal change to our deployment and how patients will be force transferred under certain parameters.
