CLCC: OEM is working on business plans for the next generation of 911. Implementation of the new medic unit dispatching protocols are changing next week. Provided a short staffing update for the CAD office.

OSFM: Community wildfire mitigation best practice course in Salem with a flyer coming out soon. Building department at the County is working towards digital plans review process and will need to know if Districts wish to have electronic or paper copies. Chapter 15 road standards (access roads) are under review with a few updates happening. OSFM is seeking success stories for seasonal staffing to help with pushing for this funding to return next week.

LCSO: No report

Emergency Management: Starting the community wildfire plan update process. Working on a fuel resilience plan project for Lane County.

Lifelight: Partnering with the stroke team at Riverbend - October 23rd tentatively, for stroke driven training and education. If you have preset landing zones you need to update, please update them so they can get it into their system.

Region 5 & LCC Advisory: Note the website for classes available. LCC advisory meeting schedules were sent out to participants.

Radio Group: Provided an update of various projects underway. There will be a credit coming back from the City of Eugene that will be put back into the finances for the Radio Group. Adcomm scope and proposal was approved by the Governance committee and is moving forward. Expect project to report back end of the year. Goal is to assist with a 5-year developed plan for how we can be moving forward on our County needs.

Wildland: Reminder about conflagration 'fee' to aid in supporting our county resources like the trailer. We're going to bill this out in the coming months. A quick update was given on the state of our fires in Lane County which have been reduced in behavior because of weather changes. Hopeful the end of season is very near.
